During a visit to the Lagos State Commissioner for Women Affairs – Mrs. Cecilia Bolaji Dada, PILA has joined their voice with other well-meaning Nigerians, civil society groups and non-governmental organizations to condemn the abysmal rise in cases of rape and domestic violence in the country.



Speaking on behalf of the association, the President of PILA, FL Joyce Ojemudia, noted that the association decided to voice out as this barbaric action against women particularly the underaged does not only dehumanize the victims, but destroys their career and future.

She noted the fact that these cases have assumed higher dimensions in recent times and this calls for the need of government to rise to its responsibility to protect women and children. FL Ojemudia urged government to put stricter measures in place to ensure culprits are brought to book and justice given to victims.

The new President of PILA said part of her focus during the two-year tenure will be to create strategic alliances with Federal and State Ministries of Women Affairs and other female Professional groups for mutually beneficial relationships with the intention to make the voice of PILA more heard in the scheme of things within the country.

CORONA VIRUS DO'S AND DON'TS

DO'S
